SUBJECT: Acquisition Security Database

I am pleased to announce the release of the newly redesigned Acquisition Security Database (ASDB), now hosted on the Joint Engineering and Testing Enterprise Portal (JETEP) on Secret Internet Protocol Router Network (SIPRNet) site. The ASDB is a centralized repository of Critical Program Information (CPI) categories designed to support the horizontal protection of capabilities critical to maintaining the advantage of U.S. Warfighters.

Following extensive testing and feedback from users across the Department, the ASDB has been improved to better support program personnel responsible for program protection and CPI management. The updated resource enables improved horizontal CPI identification efficiency by connecting program offices working with similar technologies to coordinate protection strategies. The updated ASDB also strengthens CPI tracking throughout the capability lifecycle.

JETEP is a newly developed resource on multiple classification domains providing DoD stakeholders access to trusted guidance, resources, capabilities, and data that support engineering and testing activities. The SIPRNet site for requesting JETEP access is: https://intellipedia.intelink.sgov.gov/wiki/DAF_CLOUDworks. After registering for a SIPRNet JETEP account, users can submit an ASDB access request.

Through both the ASDB and JETEP initiatives, the Department aims to promote innovation and best practices, enabling the nation's science and technology workforce to develop systems that are secure, resilient, and survivable in the face of persistent threats.
